In fact, today, under the leadership of the head of state, special attention is paid to educating potential young people who can compete with the youth of the developed countries of the world in all aspects, who have their own independent vision and opinion.

After all, it is not enough to teach science and education in the formation of young people who have thoroughly mastered modern information technologies, who think creatively, who can set an independent plan for themselves and make new innovations based on this plan. Because if we teach the youth in harmony with education, we can raise the perfect generation that we dream of, that is, a perfect person. His parents and every teacher will share his reward. If they are made to do evil, if they are left to their own devices like animals, they will eventually perish. And his guilt falls on the shoulders of those who are responsible for his education" [3].

The great allama Imam Ghazali, who touched on the importance of parents in the education of a child, likened the heart of a child to a gem, and emphasized that this gem plays a key role in its development if it is given a pattern by adults, i.e. education. Ghazali emphasizes that if he is given the right education and upbringing, he will get rewards in the end of the world with his deeds, neglecting the education and upbringing of the child, if he is given a bad upbringing, it will be the basis for the formation of animalistic traits, and his sin is the father who is responsible for the education and upbringing of the child. - he emphasizes that his mother will take responsibility.

On January 28, 2022, the decree of the President of Uzbekistan "On the New Development Strategy of Uzbekistan for 2022-2026" was signed. The new Development Strategy of Uzbekistan consists of 7 directions and 100 goals, and 55 trillion will be allocated to the activities to be implemented within the framework of the State Program for the implementation of the strategy in 2022. Soums and the fact that 11.7 billion dollars are planned to be allocated indicates the importance of the scope of work in this regard [4].

The fourth direction of the development strategy: fair social policy, development of human capital, and 33 goals have been defined in this direction. The fact that 13 of the 33 goals are aimed at the education system shows how much attention is being paid to educating a well-rounded person in our country. In particular, for these purposes, starting from pre-school education, the goal of the work to be carried out in the school education system in 2022-2026 to further increase the quality of education and upbringing has been determined. Therefore, goal 41: through the introduction of the national program for the development of schools is aimed at creating an additional 1.2 million student places in the public education system, and goal 42 is to completely revise and implement the curriculum and textbooks based on advanced foreign experience by 2026. implies. In the development of education and upbringing in school, in order to raise a mature person, it is necessary to improve the material conditions of teachers. The 43rd goal of the development strategy envisages the gradual increase of monthly salaries of qualified teachers to the equivalent of 1,000 US dollars. On the other hand, raising the monthly salary of teachers to 1000 US dollars requires them to produce a well-rounded person. Improving the efficiency of work in this regard is reflected in the 44th goal. In particular, special importance is attached to improving the quality of education in schools, bringing the knowledge and skills of pedagogues to the international level. In this regard, it is necessary to improve the activity of the Institute of retraining and advanced training of public education workers in order to bring the level of knowledge of pedagogues to the level of international requirements. In turn, it is possible to increase the potential of personnel by gradually reforming the institutions of retraining of pedagogues.

In addition to improving the qualifications of pedagogues, it is also important for students to be physically healthy. In particular, the increasing environmental climate changes have a negative impact on the health of the population living in the Aral Bay. In addition to maintaining the ecological balance in the archipelago regions, provision of free hot meals to elementary school students in the region is also provided for in the 45th goal of gradually providing elementary school students with free meals in the Republic of Karakalpakstan and Khorezm region, further development of school education in 2022-2026 is the main focus indicates that. Education, along with education, is important in raising a perfect person in our country, and paying special attention to education instead of education is becoming the main activity today.

To sum up, today the role of education and training is of great importance in bringing to maturity the young people who can compete with the young people of the developed countries of the world.
