This article discusses the most common five mistakes in the process of learning Russian. You are smooth and effortless. you start to speak correctly and naturally. Don't forget it!

THE THIRD MISTAKE is to study the Russian language only in a scientific, official, and artistic style. In language centers, they mainly study the Russian language in a scientific, formal, and artistic style. The problem is that you do not use this style of Russian widely during communication. You use simple, informal, conversational Russian when communicating with friends, family, or colleagues. You use different phrases, dialects, and slangs when speaking. If you

want to communicate freely and fluently in Russian with anyone, don't forget to learn the Russian language, which is characteristic of conversational style.

FOURTH MISTAKE - Trying to be perfect. Language teachers and language learners pay more attention to mistakes. They try to correct their mistakes. Learners often worry about their mistakes, as well as the number of mistakes they make. They focus all their attention on talking. Your main goal should not be to talk, but to communicate, to be able to explain your point of view. Your mistakes will disappear by themselves and after some time you will be able to speak Russian without mistakes.

FIFTH MISTAKE - thinking that "if I go to Russian language courses, I will definitely learn the language." Many people think that "if I go to special language courses, I will definitely learn Russian." Rather, they consider foreign language courses to be responsible for achieving their goals. This is completely wrong. Remember, you are always responsible for yourself, the teacher can teach, but 99% of the lesson depends on you and 1% on the teacher; remember. Follow the methods listed above to learn a language. Control your desires and try not to lose interest and enthusiasm. In this case, it is not known that time has passed, and the efficiency of mastering the lessons increases. You are a courageous and optimistic person. Do not transfer your responsibility to foreign language teachers. If you do not have a sense of aspiration and responsibility, no teacher or foreign language course instructor will be able to realize your goal. Only you can achieve your goal and learn Russian by yourself. It's okay if you make a lot of pronunciation mistakes, because you can correct your mistakes. They will disappear by themselves and after some time you will master the Russian language. You learned very quickly. Your pronunciation is amazing. You speak fluently. be easier for you to understand the translation of unfamiliar words. 3-5 times more effective. Research shows that you find it 3-5 times easier to learn complex, obscure words than books and other sources with easy words. What material should you study?
