
VISITING TOURISM OF UZBEKISTAN

Directly, the Orthodox Church in Uzbekistan began to take shape with the emergence of the Russian Orthodox Church in Central Asia, after the main part of this region was annexed to the Russian Empire and along with the establishment of the Turkistan general-governor's office (1867).

In 1968 year on the territory of the ancient Termez was found a Buddha statue, and since then this place has become the main object studied by many archaeologists. Later, the complexes of the oldest Buddhist temples were opened: Fayoztepa (BC. the hunt. 1-th century BC 3-th century), Kampirtepa, Karatepa. The discovery of the elements of the Ayritom Frieze, famous for the image of ancient musicians, indicates that Buddhism was propagated on the territory of this region, and the elements of the ellinistic culture were revealed. Now the Terracotta barrels of the embroidered border are kept in the State Hermitage in St. Petersburg.
